READ John 11:17-27

EXAMINE John 11:17-27

- Who are the main characters in this passage?
- What are the main actions in this passage?
- Where does this story take place?
- When does Jesus arrive?
- How far is Bethany from Jerusalem, and why may that be significant?
- How does Martha respond to Jesus' arrival? Look ahead into verses 28-33 to see how Mary, Martha's sister responds.
- What may be behind Martha's statement in verses 21-22?
- What do you learn about Jesus the listener in this passage?
- What do you find surprising in the conversation between Martha and Jesus?
- What do you find reassuring in Jesus bold declaration in verses 25-26?

APPLY John 11:17-27

- What are practical lessons have you learned from John 11:17-27
- Work on memorizing John 11:25-26, one of the 7 great I AM declarations of Jesus from the Gospel of John.
- What moved you most about this story?
- When have you faced grief from the death of someone you loved? Consider sharing that story with someone this week.
- What are you learning about becoming a better listener?
- What do you believe about Jesus and the resurrection?
