READ: John 14:1-14

EXAMINE: John 14:1-14

- For fuller context read John 13.
- To whom is Jesus speaking in this passage?
- Who is troubled?
- What had Jesus said that would have been troubling?
- What is the two-part answer to a troubled heart in vs. 1?
- What assurances does Jesus give in vs. 2-4?
- In vs. 5, what statement does Thomas make and what question does he ask?
- In vs. 6, what pronouncement does Jesus make in response?
- In vs. 7, how do we know the Father? Does this relate to vs. 1?
- In vs. 8, what is Phillip's response?
- Paraphrase Jesus's response to Phillip.
- What reason(s) does Jesus give for belief in his relationship with the Father?
- Vs. 12-13, what will the results of belief be? Why are these results assured?
- Vs. 14, what closing promise or assurance does Jesus give?

APPLY: John 14:1-14

- Are you ever troubled in life or in your faith? How does this passage apply?
- Are you ever confused about your road in life? How have you asked God to better know your life's road?
- Consider and describe what it means to you that Jesus is the Way, the Truth and the Life".
- Have you ever asked of God the same questions as Thomas and Philip? Do you believe these are evidences of lack of faith?
- Do Jesus's assurances answer issues in your life? How or how not?
- What do you think Jesus means saying that no one comes to the Father except by him?
- What is the practical application of vs. 14?

## April 2018 Update

**Search Team Members:** Brent Corwin (Chair); Mike Pierce (Vice-Chair); Athena Dickau (Secretary); Cat Wollen (Liaison); Jenn Whyman (Prayer Coordinator); David Robinson (Advisor).

**Search Team Mission:** To glorify God by identifying and recommending a full-time Associate Pastor who God is calling to partner in ministry with the Leadership Team, Staff, and Congregation.

### Associate Pastor Search Tentative Timeline:

- March/April: complete Community assessment and Community Church assessment; create Church profile; write Associate Pastor Job Description; have these documents approved by Leadership Team.
- May/June: post job opening, receive profiles of potential candidates; review, assess, and prayerfully discern candidates.
- July: interview candidates; prayerfully discern top candidate(s) and invite top candidate(s) for face to face interview.
- September: Leading candidate come preach to congregation. Leadership Team call congregational meeting to vote on calling candidate to come serve as our full-time Associate Pastor.
- October or November 2018: Associate Pastor begins full-time ministry with us.

### Associate Pastor Search Prayer Requests:

- Pray weekly for the Associate Pastor Search Team, for a spirit of wisdom, unity, and discernment, as they begin to receive applications.
- Pray for the candidate God is calling to begin to be prepared to respond to the call of God later this year when the time comes.
