- What command does Jesus give his disciples?
- What ultimate model does Jesus give for love?
- How does Jesus perceive his relationship with his disciples & why?
- How is being a friend of Jesus exemplified?
- What transformed the disciples from servants to friends?
- Who is responsible for a disciple being called?
- What fruit may the disciples bear that will be of lasting value?
- What is the singular call for disciples?

APPLY John 15:9-17
