- 5-11. What is the benefit of Jesus leaving his disciples? What happens when the Holy Spirit comes according to these verses?
- 12-16. Why does Jesus restrain himself in these verses from saying more? When will the disciples learn what they need to know? How will this instruction occur?
- 17-18. What confuses the disciples in these verses?
- 19-24. When does Jesus say his followers will be transformed from grief to joy? What is the reason for our joy in these verses?

APPLY John 16:1-24

- 1-4. What has caused you at times to go astray in your faith in the past? How do you face times of trial?
- 5-11. What impact has the Holy Spirit made in your life? How do you learn the truth about God? When have you been convicted in your spirit? When have you been comforted or deeply counseled or encouraged in your faith?
- 12-16. How has God guided you into more and more of the truth of the faith?
- 17-18. What confuses you about Jesus' teaching in this whole passage?
- 19-24. Think of a time when your heart was transformed from grief to joy? What is joy? What makes your joy complete? How do you ask God for specific things in prayer?
