- What 3 major divisions are in this prayer?

- Whose glory does Jesus seek?
- What is the source of Jesus's authority?
- For what purpose was this authority used?
- For what glory does Jesus ask for himself?
- For whom does Jesus prayer in vs 6-12?
- Describe the interplay of relationships in vs 6-10.
- Why is Jesus praying for his disciples at this time, vs 11?
- In vs 11-12, what is Jesus seeking for his disciples?

APPLY: John 17:1-12

- How can these divisions of prayer be a model for us?
- How do you live as one given "out of the world"?
- What does it mean for us to be under the protection of the power of His name?
- In what ways, do you, or can you, experience the oneness we share with each other?
- This is a prayer of the greatest of intimacies between the Father, Jesus and his disciples. How can you realize the reality of this intimacy promised to us by Jesus?
