SCRIPTURE—John 17:20-26

EXAMINE John 18:1-11

- Read the synoptic gospels version of Jesus in the garden.
- Using a map, locate the Kidron Valley and the garden to which Jesus went.
- How did Judas know where Jesus would be?
- Who did Judas lead to the garden?
- How did Jesus react to their arrival?
- How did Jesus answer their query?
- What happened when Jesus first said, “I am he”?
- How does Jesus care for his disciples seek protection for his disciples?
- What action does Peter take?
- How does Jesus respond to Peter’s action?

SCRIPTURE NOTES:

APPLY John 18:1-11

- Have you ever had your own “garden” experience?
- With whom do you identify in this passage?
- Is Peter’s action one of a faithful disciple and when have you taken action that may have been opposed to God’s plan?
