READ John 19:1-16

EXAMINE John 19:1-16

- Why do you think Pilate had Jesus flogged?
- What forms of torture does Jesus endure in this reading?
- What does Pilate declare to the crowds in verses 4 & 5?
- How do the religious leaders respond to this declaration?
- What is going on inside Pilate's mind on this day? What troubles him?
- Why do the religious crowds want Jesus to die? What do they hold against him? (see verse 7)
- How does Jesus respond to Pilate in verse 11?
- What does Pilate try to do in verse 12?
- What is wrong with the religious leaders' statement in verse 15?
- Why do you believe Pilate finally handed over Jesus to be crucified?

APPLY John 19:1-16

- What lessons have you learned from the passage to apply to your life today?
- What have you learned in the Gospel of John about the true nature of Jesus? Where did he claim to be the Son of God? Why in Jesus' time was this considered a capital offense worthy of death?
- How do you handle being ridiculed, mocked, put down, insulted or abused?
- What would your answer be to the question, 'Where do you come from?'
- Where does true power come from? (see verse 11)
