#### **READ**

#### **EXPLORE** Acts 28: 1- 10

- 1-2 On what island do they land and how do the locals treat them? Locate the island on a map.
- 3-4 What role does Paul undertake and what happens to him?
- 5-6 What do the people expect to happen to Paul? What does happen and what is their response?
- 7-8 To whose house are they invited and what happens there?
- 9-10 How do the islanders respond to Paul's work and how are they thus treated?

#### **APPLY** Acts 28: 1-10

- What model do the islanders provide as a response to people in need? How can we manifest such kindness?
- What model do the islanders also provide regarding hasty judgement? What better model can we provide?
- The people then judge Paul to be a god. How is such misdirected credit manifested in our lives and the church today? To whom is the credit truly due and how do we manifest it?
- Paul is shipwrecked yet continues his ministry to others. Who would Paul credit for this continuing ministry? How can we apply this on-going ministry in our own lives when we may be experiencing our own difficulties?
- What have you learned from this passage?
