READ Acts 12:12-25

EXPLORE Acts 12:12-25

- What dawns on Peter in verse 12? What are the believers doing in verse 12? Compare Acts 12, verse 5 and 12.
- What humorous event occurs in verses 12-16? Imagine the scene among those praying in verse 16.
- Why do you think Peter left for another place in verse 17?
- What happens the next morning in the prison area? What happens to the guards?
- What happens to Herod? (verses 19-23)
- What is happening at this time with the word of God (see verse 24)?
- What significance does verse 25 have in the story of Acts?

APPLY Acts 12:12-25

- What main lessons do you see in this passage?
- What has “dawned” upon you?
- When do you meet with others to pray? How do you “earnestly pray to God”?
- What amazing answer to prayer have you experienced or heard about?
- What door(s) are you currently knocking upon? What door(s) are opening to you?
- In what ways has the Lord brought you out of prison?
- How is the word of God spreading and flourishing in your life now?
