1 Samuel 25:32-44

Jan 15, 2017

READ: Read 1 Samuel 26: 1-11

EXPLORE: 1 Sam 26: 1-11

- Vs. 1-2, Locate Ziph on a Bible map.
- Vs. 2, Who did Saul take with him in pursuit of David?
- Vs. 5, With a Bible Dictionary, find out what you can, about Abner, Ahimelek and the Hittites, as well as Abishai.
- Vs. 6, What does David ask of his two warrior aids, and what are their responses?
- Vs. 7, Where is Saul as David sneaked into his camp?
- Vs. 8, What does Abishai want to do?
- Vs. 9-11a, What is David's response to Abishai?
- Vs. 11b, What action does David take prior to leaving Saul's camp?

APPLY: 1 Sam 26: 1-11

- David asks his men to "go down into the camp" with him. Have you ever been asked to do so?
- Does our Lord ask of us all to "go down into the camp" with Him? If so how?
- Do you find Abishai's response understandable? In some fashion, have you ever responded in a similar way when you or a loved one is somehow threatened?
- How does David's response to Abishai speak to our behavior towards those who may threaten us in some way?
- Apply lessons from the Sermon on the Mount to this situation for both David and ourselves.

PRAY AND PRACTICE:

MESSAGE NOTES

Intro: David's encounter with Abigail Continues

- Vs. 32-34 David praises God and blesses Abigail for staying his actions.
- Vs. 35, "Go home in peace, I have heard your words".
- Vs. 36-40, Nabal hears the news of Abigail and dies; David's response and His proposal to Abigail.
- Vs. 41, Abigail's acceptance and response to David's proposal.
- Lessons from 1 Samuel 25: 32-44
