READ Acts 13:13-31

EXPLORE Acts 13:13-31

- Where do the three sail in verse 13? Check a Bible map if possible to see these places. What is significant about the names in this verse?
- What does John Mark do in verse 13?
- What is the distance traveled in verses 13-14? How might Paul and Barnabas have been feeling when they arrived in Pisidian Antioch?
- Where do they first go in that city? What do they do?
- Review Paul's talk in verses 16-41. What are his main themes? What is he trying to accomplish?
- Who is Paul's audience? See verses 16 and 26.
- What does Paul tell them about Jesus?

APPLY Acts 13:13-31

- How easily do you get seasick? Have you ever been on a 200 mile sea voyage?
- When have you given up on a commitment, or backed down from an obligation because you felt overwhelmed or afraid?
- Look ahead to Acts 15:37-39 to see how John Mark's decision in Perga later influenced Paul and Barnabas.
- What "word of exhortation" do you have for someone this week?
- How well do you know your holy history? How long could you talk about the historical stories from the Bible without opening any pages?
- How are you currently sharing the story of Jesus, the Good News with others?
- What main lessons do you see in this passage?
