**MESSAGE**

Title and summarize each section:

- 18:31-34

- 18:35-38

- 18:39-43

**APPLY** Luke 18:31-43

- Think of a time when studying God's Word that you did not understand "any of this". Can you relate to the disciples in verse 34? How have you gained understanding of God's Word?
- What is the place of the death and resurrection of Jesus in your life and faith?
- As you've gone through your week, who have you met along the way who caused you to stop and consider something new?
- In what ways are you blind?
- Offer the prayer, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" Put this prayer in your own words as a heart-felt prayer for help.
- How would you answer Jesus' question: "What do you want me to do for you?"
