**READ Luke 4:14-30**

**REFLECT Luke 4:14-30**

- Where does Jesus go first after his time in the wilderness? Why? How is he received by the people?
- What may be strange about what happens beginning in verse 16?
- What day of the week? Why is this significant? What is Jesus' custom?
- Describe the series of events in the synagogue in Nazareth in verses 16-29. Notice the changes in the people's attitude toward Jesus in this passage.
- Examine the passage Jesus read from Isaiah 61:1-2. What does this passage tell us about Jesus' job description?
- Why do you think the people became so enraged?
- What might have happened at the end of this passage? What did happen?

**RESPOND to Luke 4:14-30**

- How do you celebrate the Sabbath?  
Read Exodus 20:8-11 to discover again one of God's top ten life instructions for us.
- Why do you think Sabbath keeping is not practiced as much anymore?
- How does Isaiah 61:1-2 tell us to live and serve in our time as followers of Jesus?
- How hard is it for you to care for people who are poor, in prison, blind or oppressed?
