### **Study Questions**

Oct. 12-18, 2014

R.E.A.P. God's Word

**READ** Acts 9:7-19

**EXPLORE** Acts 9:7-19

- How do the men traveling with Saul respond to the Voice of Jesus?
- What happens after the Damascus Road vision of Saul?
- Why do you think Saul did not eat or drink anything for three days? What is the purpose of fasting in such a time?
- Describe Ananias.
- What very difficult task does God give to this man?
- What is Saul's calling (verse 15)? What price will he pay to carry out this calling (verse 16)?
- What is so remarkable about verse 17?
- What is the result of Ananias' faithfulness and ministry?

**APPLY** Acts 9:7-19

- How do you respond to the Voice of Jesus? When do you hear from God?
- What place does fasting have in your spiritual life?
- How do we discern when a vision or voice is from the Lord?
- Recall a time when you faced a difficult task. How did you find strength to do what you were being asked to do?
- In what ways are you carrying the name of Jesus to others? With whom are you sharing the name of Jesus and the good news of the Gospel of Christ?
- What are your thoughts about placing hands on someone and praying for healing (as seen in verse 17)?
- What lessons have you learned from this study?
