Study Questions
Oct 19 – Oct 25, 2015

READ Acts 25: 13-22

EXPLORE Acts 25: 13-22

- Vs. 13, find what you can about King Agrippa, who he was and his lineage.
- Vs. 1-15, what background to Paul does Festus give and how does he clear himself of responsibility?
- Vs 16-17, what is Festus's prelude to the trial?
- Vs 18-19, describe the trial from Festus's perspective.
- Vs 20, why was Festus at a loss at hearing this case and what did he ask of Paul?
- Vs 21, what appeal of his own did Paul make and what was Festus's response?
- Vs 22, what was Agrippa's response and what do think led him to this response?

APPLY 25: 13-22

- Paul has now spent two years in prison in Caesarea. Why (see vs24:26-27)?
- How does Paul strive and how can we strive to have the same thing said of us as is said of Paul?
- Paul's claim is remarkably simple before the complexities of Jewish law. Do you prefer complexities of truth or simple truths?
- How do we lay claim to such truths in our lives and testimonies?
- If you knew two people were conferring about you, what would you like them to say about you?
