READ 1 Samuel 22: 6-23

EXPLORE 1 Samuel 22: 6-23

- Where is Saul when he discovers David's location? Describe the setting.
- Who makes up Saul's court and of what does he accuse them?
- What does Doeg, the Edomite, tell Saul?
- What is Saul's attitude before Ahimelech? Is he open to the truth?
- What do you think of Ahimelech's defense?
- How do the King's officials respond to Saul's sentence of Ahimelech?
- What is Doeg's response and why do you think Doeg so responded?
- Who is Abiathar and what does David say about Abiathar's news?
- What does David offer to Abiathar?

MESSAGE NOTES

APPLY 1 Samuel 22: 6-23

- David, in the Psalms, refers to God as King. From what we've seen thus far, how does David honor both God the King and Saul the King?
- Review this passage and make a list of traits that King Saul manifests.
- Make a list of God the King's traits. If you have a concordance, look at the Psalms references to God the King in making your list. Ex: Psalm 24: 7-10.
- Contrast the traits of the two Kings, and consider these traits in your relationship with God the King.
- When Abiathar arrives to tell David of the slaughter, David acknowledges his role. Do you believe David felt guilt, regret or remorse? If so, what do you think of his response?
- How does David model the proper way to handle past issues of which we are not proud?
- What is David's offer to Abiathar?
