R.E.A.P. God's Word

**READ** Luke 14:1-14

**EXAMINE** Luke 14:1-14

- What day of the week does this story take place?
- Where is Jesus in this passage? What is happening while Jesus is teaching?
- What question does Jesus ask and how do his hosts respond?
- How does Jesus confront prominent religious leaders in this passage?
- What issue does Jesus challenge them on?
- Discover the basic principles Jesus teaches on humility and self-exaltation in this passage.
- Who does Jesus encourage us to invite into our lives?

- How do you practice God's gift of the Sabbath?
- How have you experienced God's gift of healing?
