READ 1 Sam 23:14-29

EXPLORE 1 Sam 23:14-29

- After David leaves Keilah, where does he go? Try to find the locations in these verses. Some study aids and/or maps may be needed to answer this.
- How does Saul seek David and what is God's daily role in this?
- What was the purpose of Jonathan's visit?
- In vs. 17, Jonathan makes five affirmative statements. What are they?
- What aid do the Ziphites offer Saul and what does he ask of them.? What do they vow to them?
- As Saul tries to corner David, where does David specifically go in vs. 25?
- As Saul closes in on David and his troops, what news does Saul get and what is his subsequent action?
- Where does David go to seek a stronghold for he and his troops?

APPLY 1 Sam 23:14-29

- Have you had a life experience in which you felt you were in a wilderness?
- Saul is relentless in his pursuit of David; do you believe this is a characteristic of evil in the world? If so, think of specific examples.
- In the midst of this pursuit, who protects David and who protects us?
- How important is Jonathan's visit to David and what affirmations does it provide to David? Have you a "Jonathan" in your life?
- "God works in mysterious ways". How is this exemplified in vs. 27-28? Consider the surprising ways in which God may have protected you in life.
- David "went down to the rock", (a great metaphor). What does this say to us?
- What life lessons stand out most from this passage?
