PAUL'S FIFTH TRIAL***

Study Questions
Oct 26 – Nov 1, 2015

READ Acts 25: 23- 26:3

EXPLORE Acts 25: 23 – 26:3

- Vs. 23, how do the leaders present themselves and for what reason?
- Vs. 24, how is Paul presented and to whom?
- Vs. 24-25, what is Festus's reported finding regarding Paul's charges?
- Vs. 26-27 what does Festus say is his goal from Agrippa hearing Paul? What is Festus' issue? Does this give any insight in Festus' confidence as a ruler? Or, is Festus merely humbly honoring Agrippa's authority?
- Vs. 26:1, who now gives Paul permission to defend himself? Why might Agrippa hear the case differently than did Festus or Felix?
- Vs. 26:2, do you believe Paul in this verse? Why would he have considered himself fortunate for this opportunity?
- Vs. 26:3, what acknowledgement does Paul give Agrippa and why might Paul have asked for patient listening?

APPLY 25: 23 – 26:3

- Compare the Pomp of these leaders to that of Paul &/or Jesus. What truths can this comparison point to?
- Paul has thus far been found guiltless, yet remains on trial and in prison. What can we learn from this?
- It is probably a safe assumption that Paul's friends caring for him these past 2 years were also praying for him. What do you think they might have prayed? What encouragement, if any, might this give our prayer lives?
- Paul endures all these trials while being innocent. His apparent demeanor throughout all of this is calm and without rancor.
