**READ** Acts 9:32-43

**EXPLORE** Acts 9:32-43

- What place does healing have in this passage?
- What is Aeneas' trouble?
- What is the result of Aeneas' healing?
- Find Lydda, Sharon and Joppa on a Bible map.
- What happens for Peter for the first time in this passage?
- Discover how Peter handles the situation involving Dorcas. Why do you think he does what he does?
- What is strange about where Peter stays in Joppa?

**APPLY** Acts 9:32-43

- How does word of events get around our community today?
- When you've been traveling around, think of a time on a visit, when you came upon a sick person. How did that visit go?
- What are your views of miraculous healing today?
- Who does the healing? (see verse 34)
- What gets people's attention today, helping them to turn to the Lord?
- How do we honor the dead today?
- How often do you get down on your knees and pray?
- Who are you "taking by the hand" to help and care for right now?
