**READ** Luke 14:15-35

**EXAMINE** Luke 14:15-35

- What day of the week does this passage take place? What is significant about this?
- Where does this passage take place? Imagine the scene. What are the tensions in this room?
- What does Jesus do?
- How do the other guests decide where to sit?
- How does Jesus address this issue? What is the basic principle Jesus teaches in verses 8-11?
- Whom is Jesus encouraging us to invite into our life and home? How can we do this today?
- How does Jesus say we will be repaid?

**APPLY** Luke 14:15-35

- What did you learn from your study of Luke 14:15-35?
- When did you need to be careful about what you said because you were being “carefully watched”?
- How do you respond to people in need who are right before you?
- When you arrive at someone's home, how do you decide where to sit?
- Think of the fanciest dinner you've attended. Where did you sit?
- What principles are at work in this passage? How are they to be applied to our life today?
