REFLECT on 13:10-17

Scripture

Luke 13:1-9

- What happens while Jesus is in “one of the synagogues” in verses 10-17?
- On what day of the week does this event occur? Why is this significant?
- What problem does this woman have in her life? How long has she had this problem?
- How does Jesus address this problem?
- How do the religious leaders view what Jesus did?
- How do the people respond?
- Summarize each of the two short parables in verses 18-21.

RESPOND to Luke 13:10-17

- How do you practice “keeping the Sabbath”?
- From what do you need to be set free? What is currently causing you to be imprisoned or boxed in?
- Who do you know that is living in a kind of prison in their way of life, in their health, or in their spiritual outlook?
- Recall an amazing or surprising event in your life which you witnessed. How did you respond?
- What wonderful things do you hope God will do in your life?
- How is God’s kingdom being planted or growing in your life?

PRAY & PRACTICE: What one activity will you do this week in response to your study in Luke today?
