**READ John 7:25-44**

**EXPLORE John 7:25-44**

- What do people begin to ask in verse 25? Compare this question with what you read in verse 20.
- What does Jesus cry out in verse 28-29? What does Jesus know that the people do not know?
- How do the people respond in verse 30? Why were they unsuccessful?
- Why did some people begin believing in Jesus (verse 31)?
- What happens on the last and great day of the Festival of Tabernacles?
- What does Jesus promise to all who believe in him (38)? How does John interpret this saying?
- How do the people respond (see verses 40-44)?

- What confuses you about Jesus?
- What caused you to become a follower of Jesus when you first believed?
- If you currently do not believe, what keeps you from believing in Jesus?
