***STUDY QUESTIONS***  
***Peter's Dream Realized***

**READ** Acts 10:24-48      Nov. 16-22, 2014

**EXAMINE** Acts 10:24-48

1. How is Peter's dream realized in this story? What radical steps of faith does Peter take as a result of his dream?
2. How does Peter interact with Cornelius?
3. What is the kernel of Peter's sermon (verses 34-43) and how does he develop his message?
4. How does God realize Peter's dream before his eyes? What is the response?
5. Why are people astonished?

**APPLY: Dreams and Purposes**

1. Describe a dream you've had which influenced decisions you were making at the time.
2. Name one type of home which would be very difficult for you to enter, even on a casual visit.
3. How would you feel if you discovered among the residents of such a home a passionate, personal relationship with Jesus Christ?
4. Say something about human boundary lines, both the helpful type and the unhelpful.
5. What are some of the challenges facing people who are willing, in the name of Jesus, to cross over human boundaries (including race, ethnic, nationality, language, tribe, socio-economic, educational barriers)?

**PRAYER:** Thanks dear Lord Jesus, for coming to us, for crossing across the boundary into space and time to share with us your great love. Grant us courage to reach out to others with your love and Good News, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.
