**READ** Ruth 1

**EXPLORE** Ruth 1

- What significant event was going on in Bethlehem at the opening of Ruth?
- The name 'Bethlehem' literally means "House of Bread". What is ironic about this name? Read John 6 about the Bread of Life.
- What huge changes occur in this chapter?
- Find all the many heart places of sorrow in this chapter.
- Look at verse 22 in Ruth 1. What is surprising about this verse, especially in light of verse 1.
- How do verses 1 and 22 act as bookends of this first chapter of Ruth?
- If Bethlehem is a character in a story, how would you describe this character?

**APPLY** Ruth 1

- When have you known a time of "famine" or a time of not having enough?
- What are some of the most significant famines in world history, including in the past 200 years?
- Think of Ruth 1 in light of the Lord's Prayer, where we pray, "Give us this day our daily bread."
- What huge changes have happened in your life, where you made changes due to unexpected difficulties?
- Where are some of the heart places of sorrow in your life?
- How has the Bread of Heaven (see John 6:32-33) comforted you in your sorrow and fed your soul?
- Give thanks to God for providing food for your life, for your body, for your soul.
