Nov. 24-Dec. 1, 2013

READ Luke 2:1-7

EXAMINE Luke 2:1-7

- What historic references do you find in this passage?
- What does this census decree set in motion?
- Look on a map of the ancient world (if possible) and discover the extent of “the entire Roman world”, and also the location of Syria.
- What does Joseph do in response to this decree? How far is that trip?
- What extra problems does this trip entail for Joseph?
- Describe the scene in verses 6-7.
- Imagine Mary’s state of mind in these verses.

APPLY Luke 2:1-7

- What grand world events surrounded the time of your birth?
- What do you think of government census taking?
- How has a government decree/law or even a local code/law impacted your life?
- Recall a long trip you’ve taken during which surprises happened.
- What is it like to go to the place of your birth, or of your ethnic heritage?
- If you are a parent, what was your state of mind at the time of the birth of your first child?
- Imagine yourself with Mary and Joseph when Jesus was born.
