READ: The Book of Micah

EXPLORE Micah 5: 2-5

- When and in what context did Micah prophecy?
- Vs. 2, why would Micah specify Bethlehem of Ephrathah? What does Bethlehem mean?
- Vs. 2, who will come out of Bethlehem and why would it be surprising that such a one would come out of Bethlehem?
- Vs. 2, how is the “One” described?
- Vs. 3, to whom will the “One” be born?
- Vs. 4, what traits does Micah assign to the One to come?
- Vs. 4, what will be the benefits to Israel and how far will these benefits reach?
- Vs. 5, what will be the result of the coming of the “One” for Israel and the World?

APPLY Micah 5: 2-5

- What surprising places might our Lord be found in our lives?
- How can the description of the origins of our Savior, in vs. 2, add depth to our faith and our view of our lives as well as history?
- Have you ever felt abandoned by God or others? If so how can vs. 3 apply to such feelings?
- Vs. 4 says, “He will stand” is a promise for our lives. How so?
- “They will live securely.” How can this promise inform our faith walk?
- Vs. 5, in the midst of life, “He will be our Peace.” How can we apply this to our lives?
