MESSAGE NOTES

READ: Read John 8:20-30

EXPLORE: John 8:20-30

- Where does this passage take place? What is significant about this place?
- When the religious leaders want so badly to seize Jesus, what hinders them?
- How does Jesus describe what will happen to him in the future? Why? (21)
- How did the people misunderstand what Jesus was saying? (22) Why? (23)
- What will be the result if the people believe Jesus is who he claimed to be? What will happen if they do not? (24)
- How are the people described in verse 27?
- How does Jesus describe his relationship with God the Father? (26, 28-29)
- What delightful event occurs in verse 30?

APPLY: John 8:20-30

- What do you most enjoy about this passage?
- What do you find confusing or troubling?
- How well do you know Jesus right now?
- What has helped to strengthen your faith in Jesus Christ?
- If you've never believed in Jesus, the Son of God, the Messiah, what has hindered you from coming to faith?
- What are other hindrances in people's lives today?
- What can we do today to please God?
- See Micah 6:8 to discover what God requires and desires of you.
