READ 1 Samuel 24:1-22

EXPLORE 1 Samuel 24:1-22

- From where does Saul come? Find En Gedi on a map.
- In vs. 3-4, what do you think David's men were suggesting he do? But, what does David actually do?
- In vs. 5-7, what was David's reaction afterwards and what did he then say to his men?
- In vs. 8-11, as David engages with Saul, list what he says.
- In vs. 12-13, to whom does David appeal as a judge? Does David let Saul completely off the hook?
- Vs. 14, How does David challenge Saul's actions towards him?
- Vs. 15-18, what is Saul's response to David?
- Vs. 19-21, what blessing does Saul now give to David and what does he ask of David in response?
- Vs. 22, after this encounter, where do Saul and David now go?

APPLY 1 Samuel 24: 1-22

- Have you been wronged by someone in life? How does this passage encourage us to act?
- As people who have surrendered our lives to Christ, how does David model our response to being wronged?
- David appeals to the Lord to be the judge between them. Apply this to your life in any difficult relationships you may have.
- How would such an appeal effect you in your life?
- Was David's attitude dependent upon Saul's positive response to him? How does this challenge us?
- How is this passage important to our freedom in Christ?
