R.E.A.P. God's Word

**READ** Acts 10:9-23

**EXPLORE** Acts 10:9-23

- What happens about noon the following day as Cornelius' servants approach Joppa?
- What is going on one floor below Peter as he has his vision?
- What does Peter see in his vision?
- What does Peter hear as a command? How does he respond to this command?
- How many times does this vision occur? Why might this be significant?
- What is Peter's response to his vision?
- What two events occur just as Peter wakes up from his vision?
- What does Peter do? Why would this be strange?

**APPLY** Acts 10:9-23

- When have you experienced an unusual vision or dream or heard a voice telling you to do something?
- What has the Lord asked you to do, but you at first were hesitant or unwilling?
- Think of a time when you were wondering about the meaning of faith, or the meaning of some Bible passage or some vision you've had. How did you figure it out?
- What main lessons do you see in this passage?
