Study Questions

R.E.A.P. God's Word

READ Acts 11:19-30

EXPLORE Acts 11:19-30

- Find a map and discover the places mentioned in verses 19-20 where the church was scattered.
- To whom did the early church spread the good news of Jesus first? (verse 19) Why? Who heard the good news in Antioch? What was the result?
- Why do you think the church in Jerusalem, the power base of the early church, send Barnabas to Antioch?
- What did Barnabas go looking for in Antioch? What did he find? What did he do? How is he described? What was the result?
- Why does Barnabas go to Tarsus?
- Look at a map and see what it took for Barnabas to go to Tarsus, and also the journey overland on foot from Tarsus to Antioch which Barnabas and Saul took.
- Imagine verse 26.
- What kind of difficulty comes?

APPLY Acts 11:19-30

- What main lessons do you see in this passage?
- With whom are you sharing the good news of Jesus?
- Where have you traveled, and how have you spread the faith of our Lord?
- When you first meet someone, what do you look for? How can Barnabas encourage you to become a "grace-hunter" in the lives of others?
- How is Community Church growing? Check out the bulletin board in the Foyer on Church Growth.
- Who have you found to partner with for service and ministry together?
- In what ways are you providing help for others? What gifts are you sending?
