READ Luke 17:1-19

EXAMINE Luke 17:1-19

- What does Jesus say about “things that cause people to stumble”?
- What does it mean to “watch yourselves”?
- What does this passage say about faith?
- Summarize verses 7-10.
- What happens along the road, on the border between Samaria and Galilee?
- How did Jewish people feel about people from Samaria and about lepers?
- Why did only one man return?
- What was unique about this one man?

APPLY Luke 17:1-19

- What are some things that cause people to stumble today?
- How do you tend to deal with such hassles, irritations or stumbling stones?
- How are you currently “watching yourself”?
- What would increase your faith?
- How has your faith increased in this past year?
- Recall a time when you were healed of some sickness or disease. How did you respond?
- What place does gratitude have in your life? How might you become more grateful more of the time?
