READ Luke 5:1-11

REFLECT 5:1-11

- What is the setting at the beginning of Luke 5? What are the people doing?
- What does Jesus see and do? Why?
- What does Jesus ask Simon to do? Why?
- How does Simon react? Why?
- What is the result of Simon's obedience?
- How does Jesus use this event to call Simon?
- Who responds? Notice the pronoun "they" in verse 11!

RESPOND to Luke 5:1-11

- Think of a time when you were spending time with Jesus and something very special happened unexpectedly.
- How do you best listen to the Word of God?
- Consider taking the Sunday evening "Read the Bible for Life" series on the 2nd and 4th Sundays, 6pm.
- What might it mean for you to "put out into deep water and let down the nets for a catch"? Apply this verse to your life at this time.
- How is Jesus trying to get your attention?
- What are you most afraid of at this time in your life?
