Study Questions

February 22, 2015

Hearing the Word

READ Acts 14: 8-20

EXPLORE Acts 14:8-20

- What is the infirmity of the man healed by Paul and what was its duration?
- What is the response of the man to Paul's message and specifically how does Paul respond to the man?
- How does the man respond to Paul's command?
- In verses 11-13, how do they misinterpret Paul's message, how do they misidentify the disciples and how do the disciples react?
- In verses 15-18, what is the ensuing message of Paul? How does he use the crowd's response as a teaching tool? What contrast does he draw between the local gods and the Living God?
- Once again, how does the crowd respond and how does their response leave them open to being misled.
- In verses 19-20, who now appears to mislead the crowd and how is Paul treated?

APPLY Acts 13:13-31

- Have you ever been the recipient or a participant of such a physical miracle? What is the witness of such a miracle?
- What other conditions can debilitate us for life? Have you ever been a recipient of a miraculous intervention from such a condition?
- How do these verses suggest we respond to God intervening in our lives?
- This text demonstrates the danger of applying the Word incorrectly in our lives or in our leaders. What modern correlations might there be to this?
- How can this apparently discouraging event for Paul and Barnabus, be an encouragement for us as disciples of Jesus Christ?
