Study Questions

Feb 22—March 1, 2015

READ Acts 14:21-28

EXPLORE Acts 14:21-28

- Find the city of Derbe on a bible map (see the back of a study bible for the map of “Paul’s 1st Missionary Journey”)
- What happens in Derbe?
- Where do Paul and Barnabas go after Derbe? Why? What may seem strange about this decision? (review Acts 13-14)
- What is their purpose in returning to these cities?
- How do they say we must enter the kingdom?
- What wise actions do Paul and Barnabas do in this passage?
- In what way had the church in Antioch committed Paul and Barnabas months earlier?
- What had opened in this first missionary journey?

APPLY Acts 14:21-28

- With whom are you “preaching the gospel” at this time?
- Who has strengthened and encouraged you to remain true to the faith?
- What kinds of hardships have you faced in your life? How have these helped you enter the Kingdom of God?
- How well do you know our Elders, and how often do you pray for those who serve in leadership within this congregation?
- What is the role of prayer and fasting in your life? What have you given up for Lent this year?
- In what way has God through the church committed you to the grace of God for mission service in this world?
- What doors of faith are opening in your life this season?
