PARABLE OF THE TENANTS

Study Questions for this week

Feb 24-March 2, 2014

READ Luke 20:1-19

EXAMINE Luke 20:1-19

- What is going on in verses 1-8? What is Jesus doing? What are the “elders” concerned about?
- How does Jesus respond to these concerns?
- What is the setting of Jesus’ parable of the tenants?
- What happens to the servants who come at harvest time?
- What happens to the vineyard owner’s son who comes?
- Look at Jesus’ questions at the end of this parable. What do you hear in these questions?
- What is the meaning of the parable? What is the meaning of Jesus quote in verse 17?

APPLY Luke 20:1-19

- What are your views of authority?
- How do you respond to Jesus’ authority in your life?
- What do you learn from the parable of the tenants?
- In what way is our life like a vineyard?
- What “fruit” does the Owner of the vineyard seek?
- How is Jesus treated today in our world, or in today’s culture?
- Where do you see such problems today as violence, greed, corruption, and spiritual lawlessness?
- How might your life become more fruitful in Christ?

PRACTICE: What one activity will you do this week in response to your study in Luke today?
