Study Questions March 1--8, 2015

READ Acts 15:1-11

EXPLORE Acts 15:1-11

- Who came from Jerusalem, over 300 miles north, to Antioch of Syria? What were they teaching?
- How did Paul and Barnabas respond to this teaching?
- How does the church in Antioch handle this disruption?
- What occurs in verse 3?
- How are Paul and Barnabas received in Jerusalem?
- What challenge do they face in verse 5?
- When the apostles and elders meet for the first All-Church Council, who speaks first? What question are they considering?
- What historic event does Peter retell in verses 7-8?
- How are we saved according to Peter?

APPLY Acts 15:1-11

- When considering the long journeys made in this passage, recall a long journey you've made. What surprises did you meet along the way?
- How do you tend to respond to people who challenge your faith?
- In what ways to you relate to the debate and dispute expressed in Acts 15?
- What news has made you very glad recently?
- What do you learn from this first Church council at Jerusalem?
- What did you learn from Peter's speech?
- How are we saved?
