## LESSONS FROM LUKE

Study Questions  
Lord of the Sabbath  
Luke 6:1-11  
*March 3, 2013*

**READ** Luke 6:1-11

**REFLECT** on Luke 6:1-11

- What happened on two different Sabbaths in this passage? What is "unlawful" about picking grain and rubbing them in hands on the Sabbath?
- Notice the questions asked in this passage. Who asks questions of whom?
- What questions does Jesus ask of the religious leaders? Look up 1 Samuel 21:1-6.
- What does Jesus say about the Sabbath? Who alone is "Lord of the Sabbath"?
- What happens on the other Sabbath? Where?
- Why do you think Jesus healed a man intentionally on the Sabbath? What is the purpose of the Sabbath?

**RESPOND** to Luke 6:1-11

- How do you practice Sabbath keeping?
- As one of the top ten most important life activities (part of the 10 commandments), how does God view the Sabbath?
- How might your Sabbath be better kept?
- What do you think is at the heart of the Sabbath pattern for the week?
- What needs to be healed in your life?
- What good might you do this week?

**PRAY & PRACTICE:** What one activity will you do this week in response to your study in Luke today?
