- Who are the main people in these chapters?
- What are some of the main events or turning points in these chapters?
- What is the trajectory of the Cross in these passages? How does the early church in Acts preach the Cross and grace of our Lord Jesus?

- How does the Holy Spirit empower you to be Christ's witness and presence in our time?

- What challenges from Acts 1-14 have you heard? In what ways is our Lord stretching you right now?
