READ Luke 6:46-49

REFLECT on Luke 6:46-49

- Why do you think some call Jesus “Lord, Lord”, but do not do what Jesus says?
- To what does Jesus compare such people?
- What is the difference between those who build their house on rock and those who build their house on ground without a foundation?
- What troubles hit the houses in Jesus’ parable?
- What is the result in each story?
