READ Ruth 2:13-23

EXPLORE Ruth 2:13-23

- What surprises does Ruth receive that she talks about in verse 13?
- What was Ruth expecting from Boaz? (the normal way a foreign woman would have been treated at that time)
- What special measures does Boaz take to care for Ruth? (see verses 14-16)
- How does this help Ruth? (verses 17-18)
- What do you find encouraging in Naomi's conversation with Ruth in verses 19-22?
- What is the meaning of a "kinsman-redeemer"? From looking at Boaz's actions, what was the responsibility of this person?
- How did Boaz show Naomi kindness and protection?
- What does Ruth do after her talk with Naomi?

- What surprises have come your way recently as signs of God's grace to you?
- What are some hurtful ways foreigners are treated today?
- What special measures can you think of to help someone with kindness or protection?
- What lessons do you learn from your study in this passage that could be put to into action in your life?
