APRIL 19--25, 2015

READ Acts 16: 6-10

EXPLORE Acts 16:6-10

- Various locations are mentioned in this text. Locate them on a map and trace the route of Paul & Silas through them.
- How does the Holy Spirit guide their journey? Where are they prevented from traveling?
- The Holy Spirit provides the journey itinerary. Is it necessarily negative to be turned from some locales?
- What vision does Paul have?
- What conclusion does Paul draw from the vision and how does Paul respond?
- Note the pronoun “we” in vs10. What conclusion can we draw from this?

APPLY Acts 16: 6-10

- Has the Holy Spirit called you to a journey in life?
- How has the Holy Spirit guided your journey?
- Have you found yourself better suited to one journey or one locale than another?
- What steps can we take to insure our journeys are directed by the leading of the Spirit of God?
- How can we better live so that the journeys of “they” become the journeys of “we”?
