READ Luke 7:1-17

OPEN up Luke 7:1-17

Think of a dramatic “near death” experience you’ve had. How did this experience influence your life outlook?

REFLECT on Luke 7:1-17

- **Who?** Who is involved in the two stories?
- **What:** What other events happen in these stories?
- **When:** When does all this take place?
- **How:** How do the different characters respond to Jesus differently?
- **Where:** Where is Jesus located in these two stories? Find these places on the map.

RESPOND to Luke 7:1-17

- In living for Christ, what difference might it make if you lived more by trust in Christ’s power, and less in your own reputation or goodness?
- What did you learn about Jesus from our two stories?
- How does Jesus’ love and authority work in your life at this time?
- How has Jesus touched your life, including in a time of crisis, grief or loss?
