READ Ruth 1:11-22

EXPLORE Ruth 1:11-22

- If possible, look on a map to find ancient Moab. See where Moab is in relation to Bethlehem.
- What advice does Naomi give to her daughters-in-law in verse 1:11?
- Why? See verses 1:12-13?
- What is the state of Naomi's heart (see verse 13)?
- How does Naomi describe her relationship with God? (See vss. 20-21)
- What does Orpah do?
- What does Ruth do? What is so surprising about Ruth's pledge? How does Naomi respond?
- What happens when Naomi and Ruth arrive in Bethlehem? What time of year do they arrive?

APPLY Ruth 1:11-22

- Where have you traveled this past year?
- What do you know about famine and the impact of this natural disaster upon humans?
- How do you tend to face painful loss?
- Who has stood with you when your heart was grieving and bitter with pain of loss?
- What promises or pledges have you made that you've kept, even though it cost you great sacrifice?
- Who do you most relate to in this story?
- Is your life more "full" or more "empty" at this time? How might you become filled once again?
