**READ** Acts 16:17-40

**EXPLORE** Acts 16:17-40

- “Suddenly” what happens which surprises everyone?
- How does the Jailer respond?
- How does Paul respond?
- What then does the Jailer do? Why would this be considered strange in that setting?
- What do Paul and Silas tell the Jailer to do?
- Look at the next set of actions. What stands out to you?
- What happens at daylight?
- How do the Magistrates and Paul interact in this passage? Why? What does Paul demand of these civic leaders?
- What do the Magistrates do to appease Paul?
- Where does Paul go before leaving Philippi?

**APPLY** Acts 16:17-40

- What sudden event has happened in your life which changed the course of your life?
- If you’ve ever been through an actual earthquake, how did you feel at the time?
- What “ground-shaking” events have you gone through in your life?
- In what ways has the Lord released you from some kind of prison?
- What must we do today to “be saved?”
- When did you first receive God’s gift of salvation by believing in the Lord Jesus?
- How have you held another person accountable for some action of injustice?
- If you were to leave town for a long time, who would you want to see before leaving?
