Study Questions  
May 12-18, 2014  
R.E.A.P. God's Word

**READ** Acts 2:1-13

**EXAMINE** Acts 2:1-13

- What is significant about the Jewish festival day of Pentecost (also known as the Festival of Shavuot or Weeks; See Leviticus 23:15-16)?
- Originally, the Festival of Weeks celebrates the giving of the Law. What does the Acts 2 Pentecost celebrate?
- What unusual event occurs in our passage this week?
- What strange signs are manifested?
- How many languages? Where did the speakers learn these languages?
- Who is present? Find these places on a map of the Bible world.
- How do onlookers respond? (see verses 12-13). Why?

**APPLY** Acts 2:1-13

- What did you learn from your study of Acts 2:1-13?
- Consider a time in your faith journey with Christ when you've been filled with the Holy Spirit. What happened at that time?
- What do you think of when you hear the phrase "they were filled with the Holy Spirit"?
- When have you been in a room where other languages were being spoken? How did you feel about those people?
- How many languages have you learned, even if only a few phrases? Have you ever heard people speaking in other tongues as the Spirit enables them?
- What amazes you most about God's Spirit?

**PRACTICE/PRAY:** What one activity will you do this week in response to your study in Acts today? Pray for the Lord's Word to take root in your life this week.
