READ Luke 8:1-15

REFLECT Luke 8:1-15

- What occurs in verses 1-3?
- Who is involved?
- What is the “good news” of the kingdom of God? Look in previous “red-letter” sections of the Gospel of Luke and discover Jesus’ teachings thus far in this Gospel.
- What parable does Jesus tell in Luke 8:5-15?
- What types of soils is the seed scattered among?
- What is the result?
- How does Jesus interpret this parable?

RESPOND Luke 8:1-15

- How have you heard the good news of the kingdom of God? Who told you?
- How do you seek to support the ministry of Christ with your time and finances?
- Which of the four types of soil do you most relate to?
- What type of fruitfulness and harvest do you hope will occur in your life? What will need to happen for this to occur?
- What current obstacles (birds of the air, lack of moisture, thorns) are getting in the way of growth of the kingdom of God in your life?
