**READ** Acts 16:16-25

- How does Paul respond? What is his attitude?
- What specific words does Paul use to release this woman from evil?

- How do the people of Philippi respond? Why do you think they get so upset?
- What happens to Paul and Silas?
- What are they doing in the Philippi prison?

- What causes you to get annoyed?
