Study Questions

May 9–14, 2016

READ Ruth 4:1-12

EXPLORE Ruth 4:1-12

- Vs. 1: In the storyline, to what does “meanwhile” refer?
- Vs. 2: Where does Boaz go and whom does he invite to sit with him first and then second?
- Vs. 3-4: What is the initial response of the guardian-redeemer?
- Vs. 5-8: How does Boaz respond and then the other guardian-redeemer respond? How is their decision sealed?
- Vs. 9-10: Describe Boaz’s announcement and the facets of the agreement.
- Vs. 11: Describe the people’s response.
- Vs. 12: Describe the blessing bestowed upon Boaz and, by extension, Ruth and Naomi.

APPLY Ruth 4:1-12

- How does Boaz honor his community by his actions?
- What communities are seen in this text?
- What lessons can we learn from the considered responses of both guardian redeemers?
- This is a beautiful picture of community in Ruth’s time. Have you experienced such community? If so, when?
- Boaz receives a blessing that goes beyond just him. What blessings, if any, have been pronounced upon you in your life?
- What blessings can we pronounce upon others?
- What lessons most stand out from this passage?
