READ Acts 18:18-28

EXPLORE Acts 18:18-28

- Look back at Acts 18:2-3. What do you learn about Aquila and Priscilla in those two verses. What stands out?
- In verse 18, what does Paul decide to do? Who travels with him? Why? Why might Paul have gotten his hair cut at Cenchrea?
- When Paul arrives in Ephesus, what does he do? Look back in Acts (see 17:2; 17:10; 18:4) to see Paul's pattern for ministry.
- What does Paul promise in verse 20? How does he qualify this promise?
- Where does Paul travel in verses 20-23? Follow these on a map (if possible).
- Who does Luke tell about beginning in verse 24? What is unique about this person?
- How do Priscilla and Aquila treat Apollos? What is the result?

APPLY Acts 18:18-28

- If you are married, how have you viewed your marriage as ministry?
- If you are single, when has a married couple helped nurture your faith?
- What are challenges married couples may face regarding ministry for Christ?
- How have you reached out to others by faith through the ministry of hospitality?
- Do you prefer to serve with others or serve alone? What can we learn from this passage about ministry together?
- Think about sacred travel, "according to God's will". How do you decide where to travel, and how can travel become an act of faith?
- Who helped you grow in God's Word?

PRACTICE & PRAY: What one activity will you do this week in response to your study in Acts 18 today?
